Su.Pa. "Successful paths, supporting human and economic capital of migrants" is a project funded by the European Union in the field of Thematic Programme of Cooperation with third countries in the areas of migration and asylum. The project will last 36 months and its activities will be completed in January 2012.

The project aims to **promote pathways to "return of production" of Senegalese migrants in their country of origin**, particularly in the region of Kaolack, and to strengthen institutional cooperation on migration issues between the regions of origin and destination involved in the project. Furthermore, the project aims to eradicate the difficulties in credit access for migrants and to promote innovative ways to support the return of human and economic capital in Senegal.

The final event aims to present the projects results and to deepen some topics emerged during the activities implementations.

In particular, the event calls attention to the role of public authorities in supporting foreign entrepreneurship and in linking migration and development.
